Normal Curve Equivalents (NCE): This score provides an equal interval scale; thus, they should be used instead of percentiles when interpolating or averaging scores.

National Individual Percentile Rank (PR/S): This score indicates the relative standing of a student in comparison with students from the same grade in the national norm (reference) group who took the test at a comparable time.

Grade Equivalent (GE): This score represents the average performance of students tested in a given month of the school year. (Grade Equivalents are not comparable across subtests)

PHS: Post High School (13.2).
